Allie Billings hired as new second-grade teacher at Holyoke Elementary School.

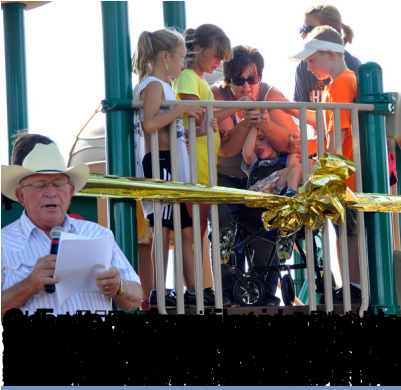
