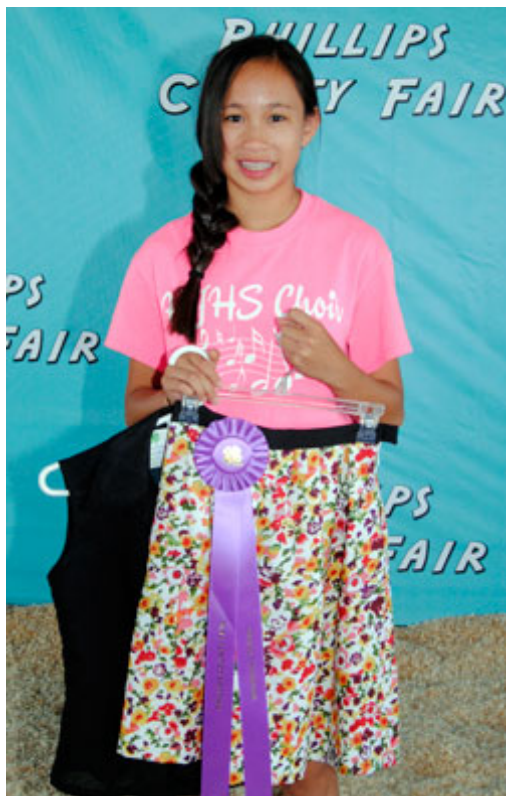


Jelden continues to excel in 4-H clothing at 2013 state fair
