

RRWCD to hold regular meeting

The board of directors of the Republican River Water Conservation District will be holding its regular quarterly meeting in Wray Thursday, Oct. 11 from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. at the Wray Ambulance Facility.

Items on the agenda include receiving program updates and reports, including reports from the RRWCD's engineer and legal counsel; recognize appointments of directors for new terms from Lincoln, Sedgwick and Washington counties, the Central Yuma, Plains and W-Y Ground Water Management districts; election of officers; review committee assignments; approve resolution to hold special board meeting in Greeley; hold budget hearing on proposed 2013 budget; consider and approve budget and appropriations for 2013; as well as other matters.

The board will open the meeting for public comment at 1 p.m.
