

Emergency loans available for drought

In accordance with 7 CFR 759.5(a), Secretary of Agriculture Tom Vilsack designated 30 Colorado counties as a primary natural disaster area due to a recent drought.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, these counties have suffered from a drought intensity value during the growing season of D2 (Drought-Severe) for eight or more consecutive weeks or D3 (Drought-Extreme) or D4 (Drought-Exceptional).
