Girls' relays earning top honors included the 4x100 meter and sprint medley relays with tracksters Mallory Bennett, Jacinda Krueger, Duester and Vasa.

HHS girls earned fourth place out of 28 teams with 60 points.

With 15 points, Holyoke boys were ranked 14th out of 24 teams at Saturday's meet.
