Tuesday, June 5; host Ogallala, Neb. Thursday, June 7; travel to Julesburg Tuesday, June 12; host Yuma Thursday, June 14; travel to Haxtun Tuesday, June 19 and travel to Wray Thursday, June 21.

The league tournament will be played in Ogallala Tuesday-Thursday, June 26-28.
